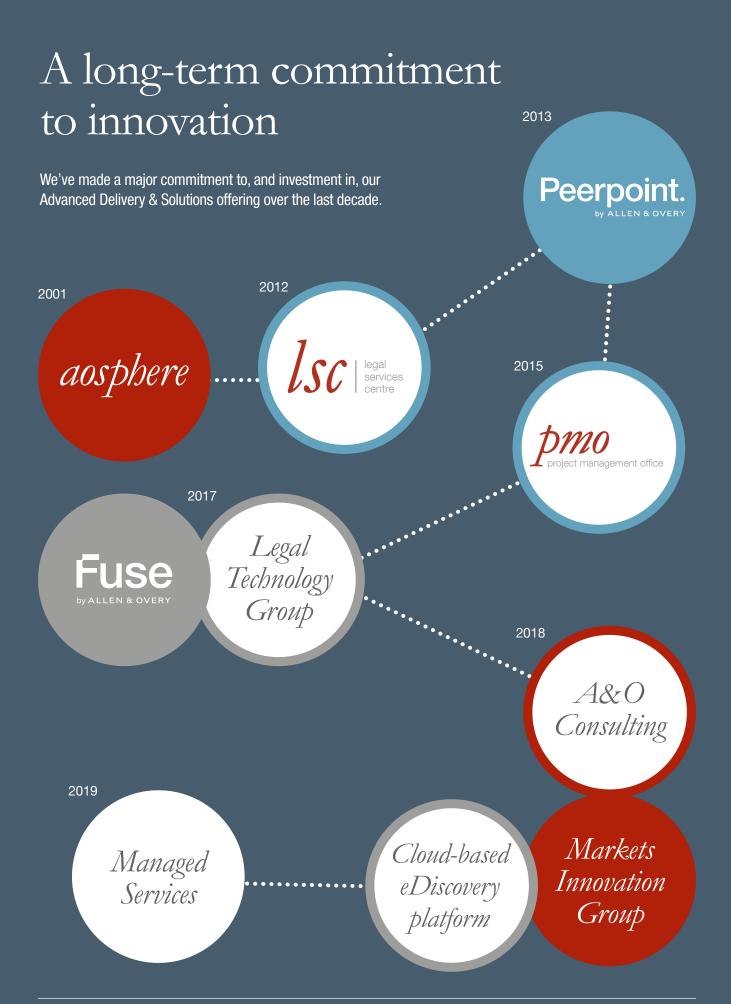

#### CASE STUDY

Meeting a major client compliance challenge by developing our own technology solution

#### **CHALLENGE:**

A global bank had to review millions of documents to secure compliance with a major regulatory requirement.

A cloud-based solution, BrexitMatrix, hosted on a HighQ platform which offered document automation, data management, file sharing, workflow management, project management and data visualisation.
