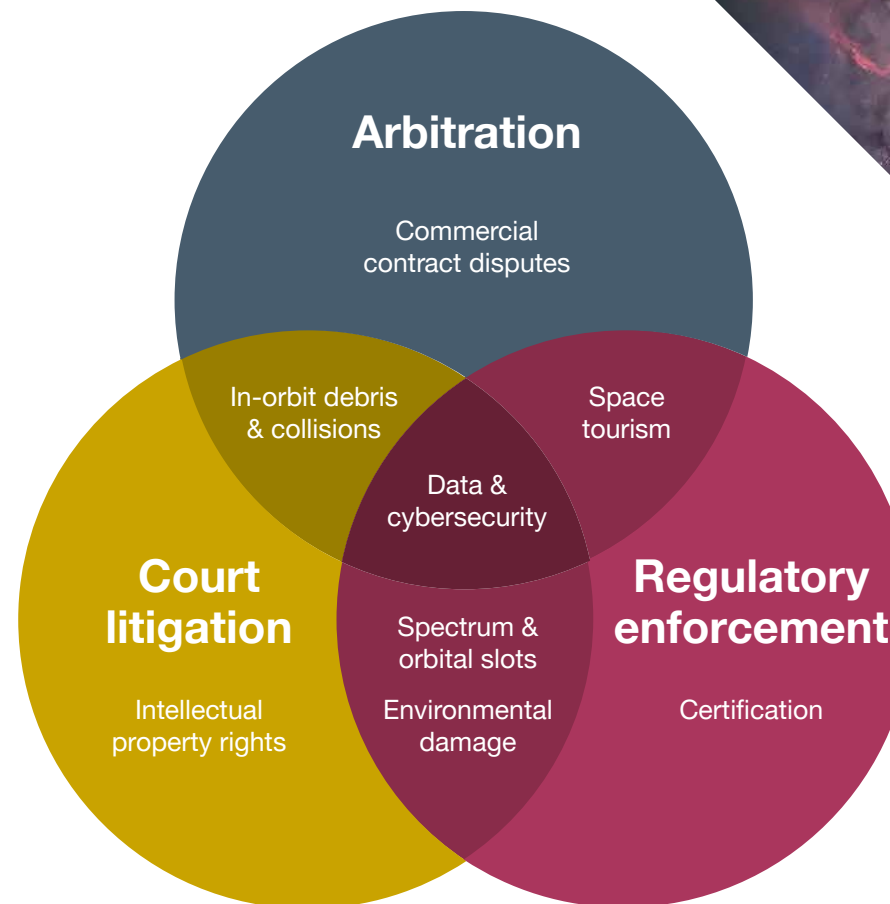


Litigating legal black holes
